3. Community Engagement/Glebe Field

Cllr Wadsworth reported that the committee has narrowed down the prospective suppliers to 2 companies, and will shortly make a decision. Final costs are likely to be either £70,000 for supply and fit, or £35,000 for supply only. Works will hopefully be complete by early summer. Maintenance costs for the Glebe Field and Old Orchard have been budgeted, but the council needs to appoint a contractor – Cllrs Morrish and Skinner will assist in drawing up a specification, then an advert will be placed initially in the newsletter.

Cllr Knill reported that the costs for the landing site for the Devon Air Ambulance would be £3381. He has received a donation of £1000 and the remainder will need to be fund-raised.
