The Planning Application has been submitted for the whole field. The Orchard/Dog walking area is half way to completion. A councillor grant has been received towards the improvements to the old ammunition hut and the materials for this have been purchased. The committee is considering a grant application for planting mazzard trees in the Orchard.

There is some scrap metal on the field – it was agreed that Cllr Dodd will attend with his trailer to pick this up and take it to SW Metals. Cllr Lane will assist with a fork-lift.

There was a discussion concerning the funds held by Parklands, and it was agreed that it is appropriate that the funds stay with this committee.
