Outdoor Play have offered to fix this free of charge as part of the installation of the new toddler play equipment.

David Netherway has prepared some sketches of renovation ideas for the old ammunition hut. These will be considered by the Glebe Field Committee.

Cllr Haworth-Booth is organising the wildflower meadow project. The seeds will be sown on Sat 24th September – all volunteers welcome.
