Update on Swimbridge pumping station: The pumping station is having essential works for the village and the safety of the river in heavy rain. SWW are removing the old sealed holding tanks and replacing them with new larger vented tanks with more holding capacity. The PC have been told there will be no odours. The works will take place over 14 weeks and will have minimal impact on the Park. SWW wanted to use part of the Park car park as a safety compound which the PC objected against because the car park is fairly small and they did not want vehicles parking on Liverton Drive. SWW have a right of way through the Jubilee Hall car park but to avoid obstructing activities taking place in the hall, the PC offered SWW an area on the other side of the park's main gate of which they are going to remove the soil and stone. When all of the works have been completed the stone will remain and the bank removed and we will have a bigger car park (free of charge). The PC are also being paid £100 pw for the duration and this money will be used for the park. Vehicle movements will be kept to a minimum, but please approach with safety in mind. You will notice a welfare unit and a container in the car park at present but these will be moved within the compound as soon as it's been prepared.

Swimbridge Jubilee Hall News We have refurbished the Hall wooden floor, which looks fantastic! We are currently putting in grants for solar power and an electric car charger—watch this space for updates. We are looking for a volunteer to help set up the stage lights using the

Reporting potholes So far this year DCC have received thousands of reports of potholes from members of the public. Each report is assessed on the ground, by a trained Highway Safety Inspector, in accordance with our Highway Safety Policy. A very high percentage of reports are either duplicates of existing reports or don't meet safety defect criteria, and are therefore closed down. A significant portion of these have been logged around the Swimbridge area, often with dozens of reports on the same road which are visited and closed down, only for them to be re-reported again very quickly and in similar quantities. Before logging a report of a pothole please familiarise yourself with the criteria on the reporting page and note that deliberately logging defects that do not meet this criteria will not result in a repair and may serve to divert resource away from defects on the network that do represent a risk to our highway users.
